If we stole or use someone's material, we must quote that in the references. We can't copy as it is and should change it by converting in our own words.


On Environment and Sustainable Development of Rural India: Issues, Problems and Solutions




Principal B.B. Mote delivered his introductory Speech during Online National Conference

"Revised Assessment and Accreditation Framework of NAAC with Specific Reference to Qualitative Metrics"

The college organized One day National Webinar on 16th July 2020 at 11.00 AM. The Resource person for the webinar was Dr. Ayub Shaikh, Member of IQAC Cluster, India. Dr. K.D. Jadhav chaired the session. Principal of college Mr. B.B. Mote in his introductory speech gave the brief review of the progress of the NAAC work. He adds that we have prioritized for the accreditation of the college from NAAC. So, our staff is working on to assess the college from NAAC.

NAAC coordinator of the college, Dr. M.L. Somwanshi gave brief introduction regarding the Qualitative metrics. He said that Peer team visit is totally based on qualitative metrics. So, the development of physical infrastructure is essential to get the college accredited from NAAC.

Resource Person Dr. Ayub Shaikh told the qualitative metrics consists of on sight visit. Institution should focus on development of physical infrastructure. Student should get each facility and college must maintain the quality. He described all qualitative metrics criterion wise. Qualitative metrics are of one of the main components of Self Study Report based on which the NAAC's grading is determined. He added these metrics are mainly to elicit qualitative responses as a standard of measurement from higher education institutions.

Dr. Shaikh said that as per the revised NAAC guidelines there are 41 qualitative metrics for affiliated colleges which covers all seven criteria of NAAC including Curricular aspects, Teaching-Learning and Evaluation, Research, Innovations and extension, Infrastructure and Learning Resources, Student Support and Progression, Governance Leadership and Management and Institutional Values and Best Practices. He told colleges must give priority to Qualitative metrics. He insists that Annual Teaching Plan, Time table, staff meeting, arranging various curricular and co-curricular activities are important for the effective curriculum

delivery. The institution may arrange various programmes for the enrichment of curriculum consisting human values, Sustainable development, Professional ethics etc.



The institution should focus on the continuous internal evaluation to maintain the quality. He said that online use of resources during the internal evaluation is given preference by NAAC. He said that Programmes Outcomes and Course outcomes help to the assessment of students. He adds, extension activities may be focused and student's participation is necessary. He said institution should arrange guest lectures of eminent speakers for the enrichment of students. Infrastructure with the adequate technology is essential for the quality initiatives of the institution. Computer lab, wi-fi facility, Laboratory, well equipped Library, play ground is required while facing to the NAAC.

As concerned to student support and progression, the representation of student on various committees is required. He said timely redressal of grievances is needed to maintain discipline and to solve the doubts of students. It should be through proper mechanism and principal should look after the queries to students. He said IQAC should be dynamic to create quality culture at the institution. 

"Migration and Literature"

Department of English, Shankarrao Jawale Patil Mahvidyalaya, Lohara has organized One day National Webinar on 4th October 2020 at 11.00 am. At least 2695 participants from all over India registered for the webinar and one participant from abroad is also registered and participated. Principal of college Mr. B.B. Mote in his welcome address gave brief introduction about the webinar and thanked to all resource person for their presence.

The chief guest for the inaugural session was Dr. Uttam Ambhore, Chairman, Board of Studies in English, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marthwada University, Aurangabad. He explained the concept of migration and how it relates to literature. People from Asia migrated and settled at no man's land. People usually travel from one place to another with some intention. He adds, we saw recently during covid period where people were migrated from Mumbai and other major cities to their native places.

Every human activity is concerned with the migration. The mix culture is the product of migration and it is related to literature also. Some times the migration is forced for e.g., African people were forcibly migrated to America as slaves. He said that the history of literature is related with migration. Renaissance in American literature is best example of relationship between migration and literature. African people try to inculcate their language, culture and tradition and at the same time they accept English culture and language also. He gave examples of Indian writers Girish Karnad and Premchand who wrote in different way about migration. God of Small of Things of Arundhati Roy deals with theme of migration. How the caste system effects people to migrate another place that is portrayed by Arundhati Roy. Refugee literature is also deal with the literature of migration and how people ignore the refugees. Hybrid community is product of migration and there are chances of clashes between two communities.

Keynote speaker Dr. Pradeep Trikha Professor of English, Mohanlal Sukhadia Univeristy, Udaipur talked on how migration and literature related. He gave the example of major cross border migration in the 20th century including the formation of Bangaladesh and most of the people migrated to India. In recent pandemic period, people were homeless and walked down hundred of kilometers to reach at home. So, these themes also will come in future writings.

The situation of migration and displacement gives birth to many crises. The creative narrative built upon the ongoing covid 19 pandemics. He told horrific situation of covid 19 with the example of one 23-year boy who after walking down

1200 km from Bengaluru to his birth place and died of snake bite after reaching at the home. Now we are living in the age of migration and crisis. He adds that migrant literature is either written by migrants or tells the stories of migrants and their migration. He added that for the students of literature the pandemic is a fertile ground. During the Question- Answer sessions he cleared all doubts of participants.

First Plenary Session is chaired by Dr. Rupali Palodkar from Sillod and Resource person, Dr. Alka Singh from Dr. R.M. Lohiya National Law University, Lucknow (U.P.) talked on the topic 'Migration and Mini-narratives'. She describes certain key points including relationship and co-existence, cultural setting in terms of migration and literature. In the process of migration people live their homes and settled in to another area. He gave the example of mass migration during the partition of India and Pakistan is based on ethnicity. She gave an example of partition during the period of 17th century including people from Africa migrated to U.S.A. and European countries. People from one area migrates to another place where the setting and life style is different.



Mexican-American literature is significant mini narratives to understand the relationship between migration and literature. The shifting of Geo-Political border between USA and Mexico. Literature comes from absorptions of different parts of the world. She gave the example of Dominican American literature consists of the

body of creative writing in various genres by US- based authors of Dominican ancestry. Dominican American literature is a part of migration literature, however since 19th century the Dominicans are stayed in the U.S.A. and is based on Political and economic factors. Dr. Alka Singh, talked about Cuban- American literature that may be read in light of Cuban immigration to the United States and or Cuban exile. She said that certain variable is faced by immigrants including race, class, gender, sexuality and to struggle for survival.

Session chairperson Dr. Rupali Palodkar remarked the topic, Migration and Literature is decent during this pandemic period. She took review of Dr. Alka Singh's talks. She added the migration is movement where one person moves from one place to other. Literature and migration have certain relationship and is necessary to study in the pandemic period.

Dr. Srikanth Mohanrao from Bidar, Karnataka was the resource person for the second Plenary session and Dr. Santosh Chouthaiwale, chaired the session. Dr. Srikanth said responsible factors for migration are religious, economic, political and environmental etc. He defines migration is a process that person leaves their home due to forced displacement such as natural disaster or civil disturbance, may be described as displaced persons or if remembering in the home country. The migrant persons are always in condition of chaos. They try to connect with the culture of migrated place but cause troubles. He told two main factors are responsible for migration; push and pull. Push factors consists of Poverty and inadequate land, natural hazards, unemployment, oppressive and discriminatory treatment in society etc. Pull factors include major jobs and high wages, better living conditions, preferable housing, education, health, better environment and security.


He gave examples of migration from literature including the novel, The Great Partition by Yasmin Khan. In the novel the theme of reappraisal of the tumultuous partition and how it ignited long standing animosities between India and Pakistan. Thousands of women were raped at least one million people were killed and ten to fifteen million were forced to leave their homes as refugees. The Shadow lines of Amitav Ghosh is the best example of migration literature where every character in the novel is in the process of crossing and recrossing or even demanding new borders. The session ended with the concluding remark of chairperson Dr. Santosh Chouthaiwale.
